


## 2 Corinthians 5:17–20


17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come. 18 All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: 19 that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. 20 We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us.




# Five Default Practices Practicing a Ministry of Appeal



## Counselors feel the pressure and responsibility...

- 1. to set the right agenda
- 2. to focus on the right content
- 3. to prescribe the right takeaways and action points
- 4. to facilitate change at the right pace
- 5. to use the right amount of Scripture




## You don't have to do all the agenda–setting. You get to be collaborative...

## You don't have to hyper-focus on sin and error. You get to front-load suffering and faith...




...because they have the Spirit

...because they can discover and disclose sin







# You don't have to prescribe faithfulness. You get to invite them to choose it...

# You don't have to force change. You get to be curious...




1. ...because they have the Spirit 2. ... because curiosity is confrontative 3. ...because they will listen to themselves





## You don't have to always bring fresh Scripture. You get to recycle and reuse Scripture...
