#### **NEW COURSE FOR PASTORS**

In the fall of 2024, we piloted a new course:
Biblical Counseling for Pastors, taught by Ed Welch.
CCEF desires to more effectively equip pastors, and this course is the culmination of many conversations, surveys, and years of classroom and pastoral experience. Over ten weeks, twenty-one pastors engaged in conversation about topics including anxiety and depression, psychiatric diagnoses, trauma, and a theology of the body. Together they considered how to grow as shepherds of the flock, all at a pace designed to fit into a busy pastor's schedule. We reached full capacity (100 pastors) in the January 2025 term, and it's our hope that more and more pastors would grow in wise care and counsel through this course.


#### **FUNDRAISING 2014 - 2024**
